A history of St. Josephs' Maori Girls College

This College, situated amid ideal surroundings in Greenmeadows, Hawkes Bay, N.Z., is a modern residential Secondary School for Maori girls.

The spacious grounds of the College provide playing-courts for tennis, basketball, marching, swimming, life-saving, and athletic sports generally.

Besides a careful religious and moral training, the educational course comprises the various branches of a sound education. All pupils learn the Maori language and culture, and take a practical course in Homecraft. They may prepare for the University, Teaching, Nursing, Dental-nursing, and Business Professions and may enter for any of the Public Examinations. The curriculum also provides for tuition in music and singing and this provides the opportunity for the renowned choir.

The College was first founded, by The Sisters of Our Lady of the Missions, almost one hundred years ago and until 1935 was situated on Bluff Hill, Napier. In that year, owing to the need for expansion, the Sisters purchased the present site on which they built the lovely College that exists to-day.

From its inauguration on Bluff Hill, St. Josephs' College has trained and educated some thousands of Maori girls who as the mothers of the Maori race have left the impression of their training and culture on succeeding generations of their people. The appreciation and loyalty of past pupils are shown by their registering years ahead for a place in their Alma Mater (to ratou kura whakatupuranga) for their young daughters.
